Colonel William G. Brey Scholarship Fund

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be a child, ward, or lineal descendant (including grandchild, great-grandchild, or great-great-grandchild, natural or adopted) of a living or deceased officer, warrant officer, or auxiliary member of the Redwood Empire Chapter of MOAA. Living members sponsoring an applicant must be current and in good standing at the time application is submitted; deceased members in whose names as sponsors descendants submit applications must have been in good standing at time of death.
2. Must have graduated from high school, or be scheduled to graduate at end of current semester.
3. Must be planning to attend an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university at undergraduate level or be planning to enroll in a professional certification program such as police or fire academy, paralegal, or paramedic training. The COL Brey Scholarship program is not intended to support graduate or postgraduate studies.
4. Item deleted.
5. Must enroll as a full-time student (12 units/semester or equivalent for certification programs).
6. Must submit a complete application before the annual cut-off date, usually March 15 of each year. The application and its instructions clearly state documentation to be attached.
